## 2017 NEWS AND TRAINING

**New for 2017**-Any agency can start in the Core Standards Verification Program, comprised of 49 WILEAG standards. Upon recertification in 3 years, agencies starting in CORE that serve a population base of over 10,000 or a sheriffs agency serving a population over 30,000, must then work to achieve full accreditation. Any agency under these population bases can remain in CORE, or also try to achieve accreditation. Any agency, regardless of population base, can also start with full accreditation at any time.

### 2017 TRAINING

March 30, 2017 Core Standards Verification Program Orientation (8 hours)

April 3, 2017 Assessor/Advanced Assessor Training (8 hours). This is a new format both section will be Taught during this training

April 27, 2017 Team Leader Training (8 hours). This is for current trained assessors who would like to become team leaders.

May 11, 2017, Accreditation Manager Training (8 hours). The target audience s new or current accreditation/core manager or agency staff involved in the accreditation or core process.

September 14, 2017 Assessor/Advance Assessor Training (Repeat of April 3 training)

September 28, 2017 Accreditation Manager Training (Repeat of May 11 training)

October 5, 2017 Core Standards Verification Program Assessor Training (4 hours). This course is for previously trained assessors who want to become CORE assessors
