When requested, the LEDR Team responds to any police agency that has lost a department member to assist with the myriad tasks involved with the tragedy. Our purpose is to assist the agency by serving the survivors -- the family and the affected agency personnel -- by using our specialized training and experience to minimize the trauma of the event.
