

WCPA Website Opening Soon: “Members Only” Section

After many months of work, the “Members Only” section will soon be up and running. The Communications and Technology Committee led by Committee Chair Frank Sleeter has made considerable ground in improving the WCPA website. The latest effort, and hopefully soon achieved goal, will be that of establishing the Members Only section on that website. The Members Only section would consist of a chat room and bulletin board for our members. The chat room would provide members with an opportunity to actively chat and discuss issues of mutual concern. The bulletin board would provide an opportunity to post information, topics of interest, issues or concerns, and possibly job openings, etc. Considerable time and effort has been put in by the committee, and we are now ready to launch the Members Only section of the website.

One of the major concerns of this website is to ensure the security of this section of the website so that only authorized members can have access.

The Members Only section will be piloted in the next two weeks to test the system and work out any bugs. After considerable discussions, the Members Only section will be available only to principal members during this two-month pilot period. If a principal member has a second in command that is an associate member of the organization and they would like their second in command to be a part of this pilot project, they can provide written authorization to our Executive Director Don Thaves.

Approximately 100 principal members have provided a logon and password to access this Members Only section. If you are a principal member and are interested in participating in this pilot project, please submit a logon and password to Executive Director Don Thaves. If you wish to submit this information via email, please submit your logon and your password in two separate emails. This will help insure the security of your access to the Members Only section and improve the enhanced security of this section for all of us.
