WCPA Member Types

Principal: Police Chiefs or persons holding the highest paid appointed chief administrative position in a law enforcement agency authorized by the political subdivision of a city, village, township or the State of Wisconsin.

Associate: Persons holding full-time paid management positions in a municipal law enforcement agency, or administrative officers or directors of an authorized governmental agency concerned with the administration of criminal justice, or publicly employed training coordinators or academic staff concerned with training and education in the criminal justice field.

Affiliate: Persons holding positions in privately supported professions or occupations directly concerned with the improvement and development of the police professions technical and administrative skills.

Out-of-state Retired: Persons, who after retirement, has become a Wisconsin resident and has retired from a position that would have qualified them as a Principal Member of the corporation.

Leaders of Tomorrow: Available to non-command level sworn law enforcement officers in a municipal agency not otherwise eligible for Associate membership.
